Using the Group as a Medium of Supervision

LONDON 2020

5 weekends – from April to December

The course is open to group analysts, group psychotherapists, individual psychotherapists, clinical psychologists, counselling psychologists and counsellors, who have had three years' post qualification experience.

Successful applicants will be expected to be working as supervisors with a group of supervisees by the start of the course or be planning to do so. The training is psychodynamic in its orientation, but therapists from other trainings, who are interested in using the group as the medium for supervision, are welcome to apply. The course covers group supervision of groups and dyadic work. It qualifies therapists to supervise both groups and individuals.

ABOUT THE TRAINING

The training involves 45 hours theory and 15 hours median group experience. In addition, 45 hours of group supervision of supervision will take place weekly either face to face or via telephone conferencing/Skype. There will be a 5,000-word essay to complete in order to qualify.

INTERVIEWS

Interviews will take place via skype or by teleconference, dates/times to be confirmed. Cost of interview: £162

COURSE FEES*

Option B: £3,418, (5 instalments of £683.60, paid prior to each block weekend).
