The Maelstrom.

An analogy for our times and the Significance of Involved Detachment.

The Maelstrom is a short story by Edgar Allan Poe, about two brothers drawn into a whirlpool and subsequent events. The story was taken up by Norbert Elias, one of the founders of the Group Analytic Society. Elias used this story to draw attention to the importance of being involved in our experience but being able to detach and think about it at the same time. He called this quality Involved Detachment. The maelstrom is an evocative symbol for a turbulent wider society and for analytic groupwork with its visceral and demanding challenges. These challenges both require a propensity for engagement with emotional experience and a capacity to think about and reflect upon the emergent group process.
